观光景点:







北京

- 天安门广场 位于北京市中心,可容百万人举行集会是世界名城中最大的广场。
- 故宮 又名紫禁城,是明清两代皇帝住过的皇宫。它位于北京市中心,面积达72万平方米,是 世界上规模最大的宫殿建筑群。故宫可以分为两大部分,南为工作区,即外朝,北为生活区, 即内廷。外朝内廷的所有建筑排列在中轴线上,东西对称,秩序井然。
- 天坛 中国现代最大坛庙建筑,它乃明、清两代帝王祀天祈谷的坛庙,主要包括祈年殿、皇宇、 回音壁、围丘、斋宫等。
- 居庸关万里长城 长城全长6000多公里,是世界上最伟大的建筑之一。长城始建于秦始皇时期, 经过历代的增补修筑,现在我们能看到的长城几乎都是明代所建。
- 颐和园 原名清漪园,始建于公元1750年;1860年的第二次鸦片战争中,清漪园被英法联军烧 毁;1886年,清政府挪用海军,军费等款顶重修,并于两年后改名颐和园,作为慈禧太后晚年 的颐养之地。
- 鸟巢国家体育场 鸟巢"是2008年北京奥运会主体育场,乃可容纳9.1万人的体育场。
- 水立方游泳馆 因表面看如一个装满水的立方体所以俗称"水立方"为奥运主要的水上项目比 赛场馆。

大同

- 云冈石窟 被联合国教科文组织列为世界文化遗产,中国十大石窟之一。云冈石窟距今已有 1500多年的历史,始建于公元460年,由当时的佛教高僧昙曜奉旨开凿。此石窟依山而凿,东 西绵延约一公里,气势恢弘,内容丰富。现存主要洞窟45个,大小窟龛252个,造像5万1千余 尊,代表了公元 5 至 6 世纪时中国杰出的佛教石窟艺术。接着游览悬空寺。此寺建于 1400 年 前北 魏后期,是中国仅存的佛、道、儒三教合一的独特寺庙。
- 悬空寺 原来叫"玄空阁"。「玄」取自於中国传统宗教道教教理,「空」则来源于佛教的教 理,后来改名为悬空寺,是因为整座寺院就像悬挂在悬崖之上,在汉语中「悬」和「玄」同 音,因此得名。
- 九龙壁 是中国现存九龙壁中建筑年代最早、最大的一座,比北京故宫和北海的九龙壁早三百 余年,大小约是北海的九龙壁的两倍.大同九龙壁于2001年成为全国重点文物保护单位.大同有" 龙壁之城"的美称,现存有九座龙壁,大同九龙壁是其中最著名的一座。
- 古城墙 为明洪武五年(1372年)在元故城墙旧土城上增筑而成,全国颇有名气.大同城墙的总周长 为7270.7米,形制方形城池。比西安古城墙高2米,最宽处16. 6米,比南京古城墙最宽处还宽6. 6 米.城墙上有62座门搂角楼、望楼。城门楼四座,其中南门城楼最雄壮,为三层重楼,面宽61米, 进深23.35米。

BEIJING

- Tian An Men Square Which located at the center of Beijing. Tian An Men Square is the largest square in the world and can hold about one million people in the same time. It is surrounded by the Forbidden City in the north, the Great Hall of People in the west and museums of Chinese History and Chinese Revolution in the east.
- Forbidden City The largest and best preserved collection of ancient buildings in China. The complex is divided into two sections - Inner Court - the living quarters and Outer Court - the working area.
- Temple of Heaven Is a place where the Ming & Qing Dynasty went to worship Heaven and pray for good harvest
- Great Wall Is a series of stone and fortifications in China, built, rebuilt and maintained between 5th Century and 16th Century to protect the northern borders of Chinese Empire from Xiongnu attacks during the rule of successive dynasties.
- Summer Palace Formerly known as Qing Yi Park, built in Qing Emperor Qianlong began fifteen years (1750). In the Second Opium War, fire burned by British and French troops. Rebuilt in 1860, as a recuperate relegated palace of Empress Dowager Cixi.
- Beijing 2008 Olympic Stadium Is the main stadium of the 29th Beijing Olympic Games. The National Stadium in Beijing, the main stadium for the 2008 Olympic Games, is dubbed the "bird's nest" because of its innovative grid formation.
- The National Aquatic Centre Also called the "Water Cube", The center will be the venue for swimming, diving, synchronized swimming and water-polo final during the Olympic Games.

DATONG

- Yungang Grottoes UNESCO World Heritage Site, one of the most famous Buddhist sculptural sites in China, Yungang Grottoes (exclude buggy). It is an outstanding example of the Chinese stone carvings from the 5th and 6th centuries. All together the site is composed of 252 grottoes with more than 51,000 Buddha statues and statuettes.
- Hanging Monastery It is built more than 1,400 years ago; this temple is notable not only for its location on a sheer precipice but also because it includes Buddhist, Taoist, and Confucian elements. The structure is kept in place with wooden crossbeams fitted into holes chiseled into the cliffs. The main supportive structure was hidden.
- Nine-Dragon Screen Wall was built at the start of the Ming Dynasty (1368).45.5 meters long, 8 meters high, and 22 meters thick. As one of the three famous walls of this style in China, the Datong Nine-Dragon Wall is the oldest, largest, and most enchanting one.
- Datong Ancient City Wall The original city wall in Datong was built in 1372 at the early stage of Ming Dynasty (1368 – 1644) upon the ancient tamped earth city walls that had been built originally during Liao Dynasty (916 - 1125 and Jin Dynasty (1115 - 1234). It was 14 meters high with a perimeter of 7270 meters and 4 main gates, 4 turrets and 46 watch towers.
