## 布达佩斯

- **渔人堡** - 渔人堡修建于19世纪。它是一个新哥特式和新罗曼风格的观景台，位于匈牙利首都布达佩斯布达一侧多瑙河河畔的城堡山。渔人堡得名于渔民行会，他们在中世纪负责守卫这一段城墙。渔人堡也是联合国教科文组织列为世界遗产的一部分。
- **马加什教堂** - 马加什教堂是匈牙利首都布达佩斯的一座教堂，位于布达城堡区。哥特式的建筑，外墙明亮的色，教堂的彩色玻璃窗还有天花板画室内更是不容错过。它是中世纪第二大教堂和中世纪的匈牙利王国的第七个最大的教堂。
- **英雄广场** - 英雄广场是匈牙利首都布达佩斯的主要广场，位于被列为世界遗产安德拉什大街的末端，毗邻城市公园。英雄广场的中心，是该市的地标一千年纪念碑，刻有在9世纪创建匈牙利的7个部落领袖，以及匈牙利其他历史名人的雕像。它结合了历史，艺术和政治等多重因素的最宏伟的建筑之一。
- **布达城堡** - 布达城堡原称作“皇宫”或“皇家城堡”，位于匈牙利布达佩斯城堡山之上。原来的建筑物为哥特式王宫，直至17世纪，哈布斯堡王朝赶走了土耳其，布达城堡被重建成巴洛克式。现时布达城堡成为了匈牙利的美术馆及博物馆，供游人欣赏。布达城堡于1987年被联合国教科文组织列入世界遗产。

## 布拉迪斯拉发

- **布拉迪斯拉发城堡** - 斯洛伐克首都布拉迪斯拉发市的主城堡，位于多瑙河畔小喀尔巴阡山脉的一座山丘之上，整体呈方形，四角各有一座角塔。布拉迪斯拉发是许多传说的美丽风景与城堡的历史连接。

## 布尔诺

- **自由广场** - 自由广场是布尔诺的最大的也可能是最古老的广场，周围有许多商店、咖啡店和餐厅，有许多贩售纪念品和服饰的商店,是主要繁华区。
- **圣彼得和保罗大教堂** - 圣彼得和保罗大教堂是捷克最重要的名胜之一。圣彼得和保罗大教堂，也描绘于捷克10克朗硬币。彼得罗夫的塔84米高。内部是在巴洛克时期的建筑风格而它的外观是哥特式风格。

## 维也纳

- **美泉宫** - 美泉宫曾是奥地利哈布斯堡皇家的避暑皇宫，素有小凡尔赛宫美誉，原为神圣罗马帝国哈布斯堡王朝的一座巴洛克风格皇家猎宫，背面的皇家花园是一座典型的法国式园林，如今是维也纳最负盛名的旅游景点。
- **霍夫堡宫** - 霍夫堡宫殿霍夫堡宫建于13世纪，是位於首都維也納的市中心宫殿建筑。这是帝王居住的冬宫，因为美泉宫是他们的夏宫。今日的霍夫堡宫殿是奥地利的總統官邸所在地。
- **维也纳市政厅** - 维也纳市政厅是维也纳的一座宏伟建筑，维也纳市长和市议会的驻地。维也纳市政厅为哥特式风格，塔楼顶部的市政厅铁人是维也纳的标志之一。

## 布拉格

- **布拉格城堡** - 布拉格城堡是布拉格最著名的建筑群，它始建于9世纪。在各城堡建筑中，古罗马式，哥特式，巴洛克式，文艺复兴式等各个年代的建筑风格可谓是布拉格的无价瑰宝。的吉尼斯世界纪录列出布拉格城堡作为世界上最大的古城堡世界。
- **查理大桥** - 查理大桥是布拉格人在伏尔塔瓦河上修建的第一座桥梁，是布拉格最有名的古迹之一。查理大桥全长516米，在这座欧洲最古老以及最长的桥梁上，是东欧和西欧之间重要的贸易路线。
- **布拉格小城** - 捷克首都布拉格一个古老的城区。其名称来源于所在的位置是伏尔塔瓦河左岸，紧临布拉格城堡下方的山坡，正对着右岸的大城，两者之间以查理大桥相连。
- **瓦茨拉夫广场** - 瓦茨拉夫广场是一个主要的城市广场和商业文化社区在布拉格新城的中心。这是布拉格世界遗产的历史中心的一部分。原名马市，于1848更名瓦茨拉夫广场。
- **天文钟** - 布拉格旧市政厅的天文钟是世界上最著名的天文钟之一，这座钟分为上下两座，精美别致而又颇具古韵，第一次安装在1410，使其成为世界上第三古老的天文钟和最古老的一个仍在工作。

## BUDAPEST

- **Fishermen's Bastion** - Fisherman's Bastion in Budapest was built in the 19th century. The Bastion takes its name from the guild of fishermen that was responsible for defending this stretch of the city walls in the middle Ages. The views from the Fisherman's Bastion well deserve their own special tower atop the Buda Castle Hill, as not only the Buda Castle but also the river views and the Danube riverfront sights are now part of the UNESCO World Heritage.
- **Matthias Church** - Matthias Church is a Roman Catholic Church located in Budapest in front of the Fisherman's Bastion at the heart of Buda's Castle District. The current building was constructed in the florid late Gothic style. The building's exterior bright color and the interior of the church's stained glass windows and ceiling paintings, it is not to be missed highlights. It was the second largest church of medieval Buda and the seventh largest church of medieval Hungarian Kingdom.
- **Heroes' Square** - Heroes' Square is one of the major squares in Budapest, Hungary, noted for its iconic statue complex featuring the Seven Chieftains of the Magyars and other important national leaders, as well as the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. It is one of the most magnificent buildings in Budapest, which combines history, art and politics, such as multiple elements.
- **Buda Castle** - Buda Castle is the historical castle and palace complex of the Hungarian kings in Budapest. In the past, it has been called Royal Palace and Royal Castle. The castle is a part of the Budapest World Heritage Site, which was declared a Heritage Site in 1987.

## BRATISLAVA

- **Bratislava Castle** - Bratislava Castle, German is the main castle of Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia. The massive rectangular building with four corner towers stands on an isolated rocky hill of the Little Carpathians directly above the Danube River in the middle of Bratislava. The location provides excellent views of Bratislava, Austria and many legends are connected with the history of the castle.

## BRNO

- **Freedom Square** - The biggest and probably the oldest square in Brno, surrounded by many shops, cafes and restaurants, there are many shops selling souvenirs and clothing is the main downtown area. Formerly called Lower Market, has still kept its original triangular shape, determined by the former routes and a creek.
- **Cathedral of St. Peter and Paul** - St. Peter and Paul Cathedral is one of the most important showplace in Czech Republic, it was built in the 9th century. Cathedral of St. Peter and Paul is also pictured on Czech 10 Koruna coin. Towers of Petrov are 84 metre high. The interior is in baroque movement. The exterior is Gothic. Above the main entrance there is written a quotation from Matous evangelium. It says something like: "Come here everybody who is toiling, I will refresh you. Your soul will find peace."

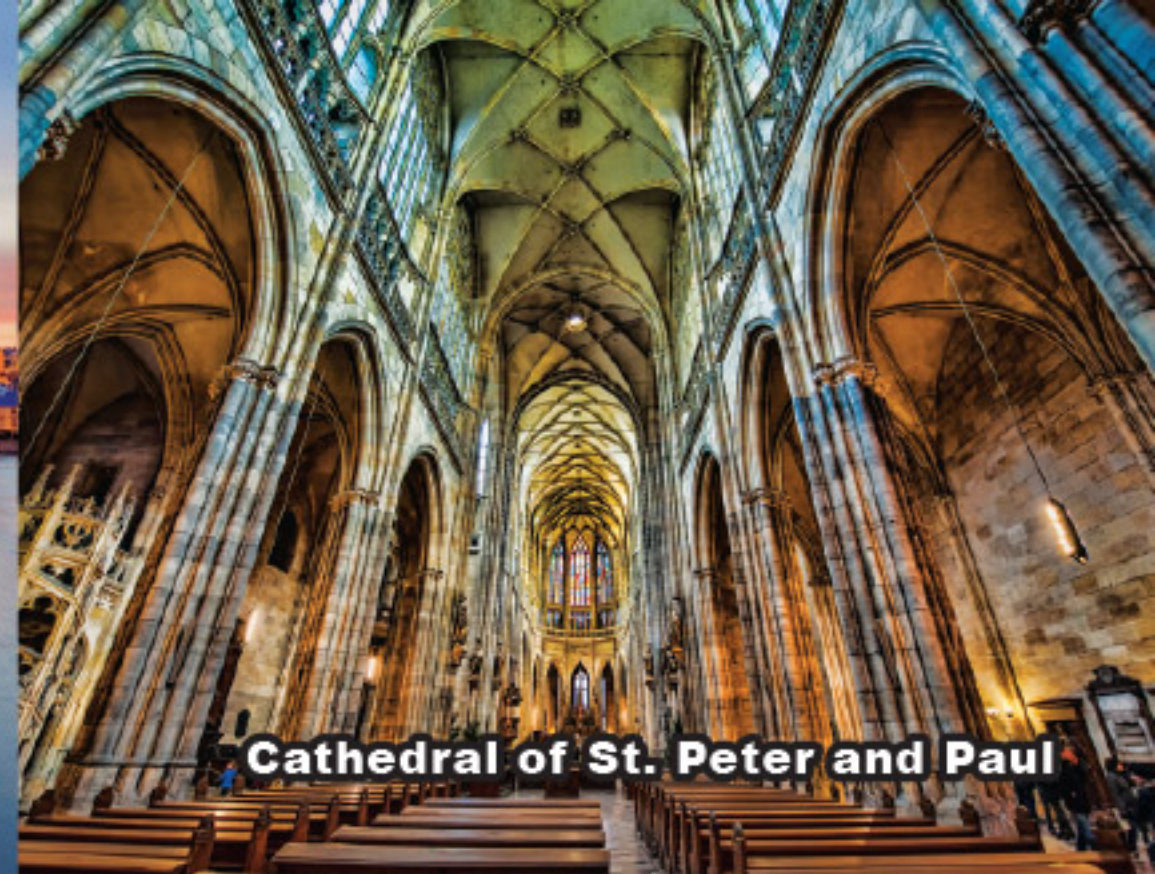

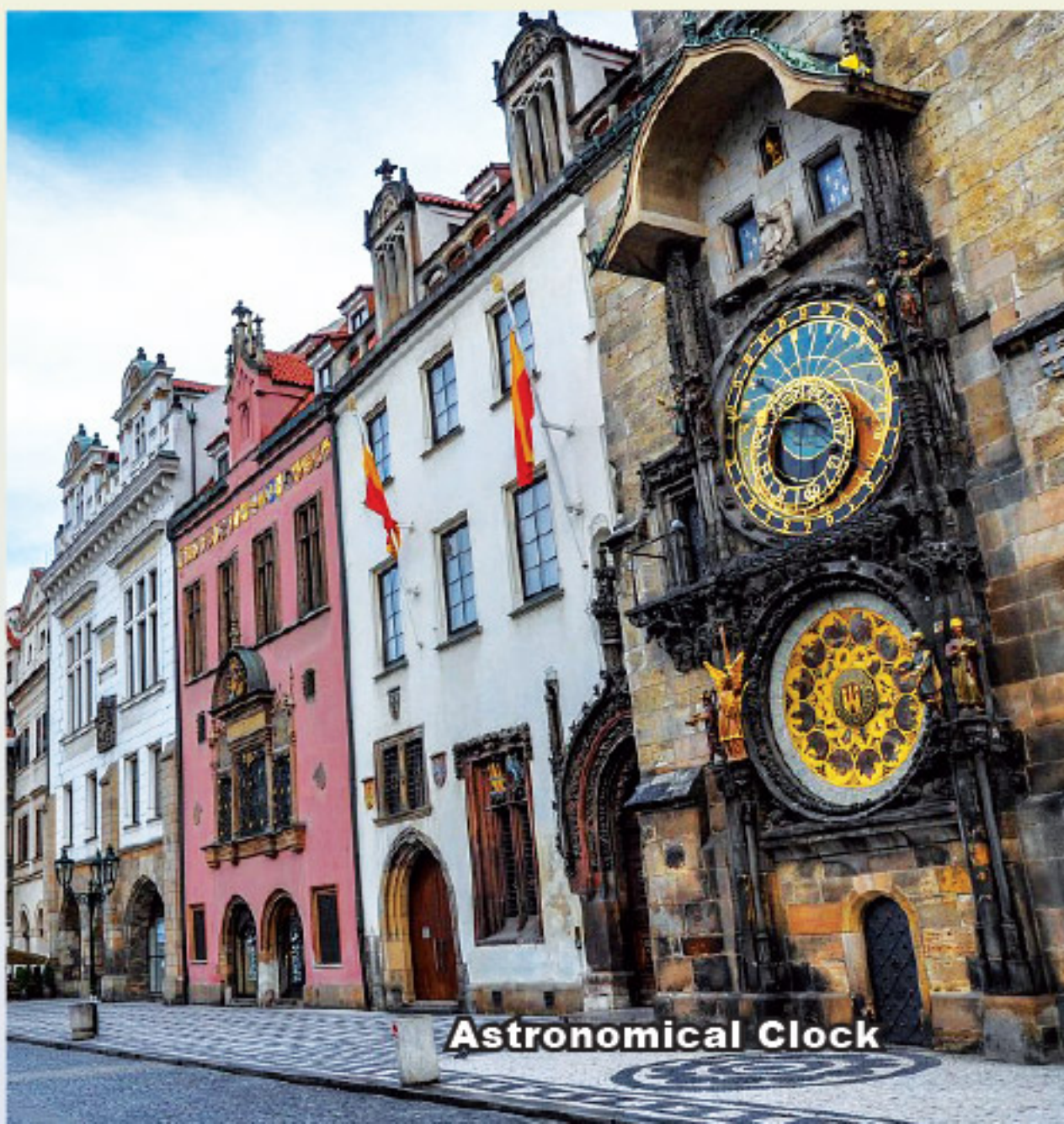

## PRAGUE

- **Prague Castle** - Prague Castle is the official residence and office of the President of the Czech Republic; it was built in the 9th century. In each castle building, architectural style Romanesque, Gothic, Baroque, Renaissance and other years can be described as priceless treasures of Prague. The Guinness Book of Records lists Prague Castle as the largest ancient castle in the world.
- **Charles Bridge** - The Charles Bridge is a famous historic bridge that crosses the Vltava River in Prague, Czech Republic. The Charles Bridge was the most important connection between Prague Castle and the city's Old Town and adjacent areas. This "solid-land" connection made Prague important as a trade route between Eastern and Western Europe.
- **Mala Strana** - Malá Strana is a district of the city of Prague, Czech Republic. It was a dominant center of the ethnic German citizens of Prague. It also housed a large number of noble palaces while the right-bank towns were comparatively more bourgeois and more Bohemian Czech.
- **Wenceslar Square** - Wenceslas Square is one of the main city squares and the centre of the business and cultural communities in the New Town of Prague. It is part of the historic centre of Prague, a World Heritage Site. Formerly known as Horse Market, it was renamed Wenceslas square in 1848.
- **Astronomical Clock** - The Prague astronomical clock, or Prague orloj, is a medieval astronomical clock located in Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic. The clock was first installed in 1410, making it the third-oldest astronomical clock in the world and the oldest one still working.

## VIENNA

- **Schonbrunn Palace** - Schönbrunn Palace is a former imperial summer residence located in Vienna, Austria. The 1,441-room Baroque palace is one of the most important architectural, cultural and historical monuments in the country. Since the mid-1950s it has been a major tourist attraction.
- **Hofburg Palace** - Hofburg Palace is the former imperial palace in the centre of Vienna. Part of the palace forms the official residence and workplace of the President of Austria. It was the principal imperial winter residence, as Schönbrunn Palace was their summer residence.
- **Rathaus** - The Rathaus (Town Hall) is a building in Vienna which serves as the seat both of the mayor and city council of the city of Vienna. The town hall also serves, in personal union, as Governor and Assembly (Landtag) of the State of Vienna, a state with the Austrian federal system.
