罗马

- **古罗马广场** - 古罗马广场又称古罗马市场，亦有“露天博物馆”之称，曾是古罗马帝国的政治经济中心，代表着古罗马建筑的辉煌，每年都吸引着大量游客参观。
- **特莱维喷泉** - 别称“少女喷泉”，但它最著名的名字还是“许愿泉”。特莱维喷泉于1762年完工，是由尼科拉·萨尔维设计完成的，历时30年才建成，是一座位于意大利罗马的喷泉，也是罗马最大的巴洛克风格喷泉。特莱维喷泉也是罗马市著名的景点，游客通常会在此地许愿。
- **罗马斗兽场** - 建于公元72至82年间，遗址位于意大利首都罗马市中心。从功能、规模、技术和艺术风格各方面来看，罗马斗兽场是古罗马建筑的代表作之一。它的施工速度之快也是一个奇迹。

梵蒂冈城

- **圣彼得大教堂** - 是位於梵蒂岡的一座天主教宗座聖殿，建於1506年至1626年，為天主教會重要的象徵之一。聖伯多祿大殿由於其禮拜儀式，是著名的天主教徒朝聖地點之一。
- **圣彼得广场** - 这个集中各个时代的精华的广场，可容纳50万人，因广场正面的圣彼得大教堂而出名，是罗马教廷举行大型宗教活动的地方。广场的建设工程用了十一年的时间(1656~1667年)，由世界著名建筑大师贝尔尼尼亲自监督工程的建设。

佛罗伦萨

- **米开朗基罗广场** - 位于佛罗伦萨市区南端的高地上，站在广场上，可以眺望佛罗伦萨市的全景，因广场上有佛罗伦萨的象征——大卫青铜像，米开朗基罗广场也就成为许多游客开始佛罗伦萨之游的第一站。
- **老桥** - 是意大利佛罗伦萨市内一座中世纪建造的石拱桥，位于阿诺河上。老桥建于1345年，是欧洲出现最早的大跨度圆弧拱桥。老桥的另一个特别之处在于桥上建有店铺，也是佛罗伦萨著名的地标之一。
- **乔托钟楼** - 紧挨着圣母百花大教堂西主立面南侧，外墙饰面风格与大教堂相近。乔托钟楼比大教堂建成得早：旧钟楼遭大火烧毁后，佛城人就请了乔托来设计新钟楼。

比萨

- **比萨斜塔** - 位于意大利托斯卡纳省比萨城北面的奇迹广场上。比萨斜塔是比萨城的标志，1987年它和相邻的大教堂、洗礼堂、墓园一起因其对11世纪至14世纪意大利建筑艺术的巨大影响，而被联合国教育科学文化组织评选为世界遗产。

五渔村

- **五渔村** - 位于意大利利古里亚大区拉斯佩齐亚省海沿岸地区.由五个依山傍海的村庄组成(蒙特罗索、韦尔纳扎、科尔尼利亚、马纳罗拉及里奥马焦雷)。1997年，被联合国教科文组织列入世界文化遗产名录，1999年被评为国家公园。

- 蒙泰罗索 - 是五个渔村中最大的一个，位置最偏西北。由中间的铁道分为新旧城，新城临海，旧城靠山。新区拥有五渔村最好的沙滩，有些嵌在岩石里的巨大雕像很值得观赏。山那一边的老城区则适合散步，逛街道教堂。村子以柠檬和凤尾鱼而闻名，油炸或配柠檬汁生吃都风味极佳。
- 韦尔纳扎 - 是建在悬崖边上的渔村之一。在依山而建的层层葡萄架与柠檬树林下，五彩的楼房，是五渔村中最精致也是最热闹的小镇，也是最常在明信片上出现的地方。海边广场无数的小餐厅里可以边吃边欣赏利古里亚海的美景。
- 科尔尼利亚 - 坐落于高耸的山崖峭壁上，是五渔村中唯一没有靠海而建的。如果走徒步路线，需要爬300多级台阶才能进入，比较方便快捷的是选择巴士或火车从其他村落前往。
- 马纳罗娜 - 是五渔村中著名的旅游胜地之一。传统上，马纳罗娜的主要产业是捕鱼和酿酒。村里几乎所有的房屋都涂成明亮，鲜艳的颜色。海边的马纳罗娜火车站，站台上就可以看见美丽的风景，一路，火车翻山过隧道，每到一站都是一片豁然开朗的海。“爱之小道 Via dell' Amore” 全长1.2公里，是连接马纳罗娜与里奥马焦雷的路径，风景最好的徒步旅行路线。
- 里奥马焦雷 - 地处最南端，是五个村镇中最大的一个。里奥马焦雷因镇上的房屋被涂上传统色彩而闻名于世。以其历史角色和村子葡萄园产的酒而出名。渔村有一个隐蔽的砾石海滩，还有一个停泊着五颜六色渔船的小码头。

米兰

- 斯福尔采斯科城堡 - 诺尔多车站背面左手边是斯福尔采斯科城堡。据说列奥纳多·达·芬奇也参加了建筑这座城堡。1466年完成。
- 埃马努埃莱二世长廊 - 该埃马努埃莱二世是世界上最古老的购物商场之一。坐落在米兰市中心一栋四层双街机，该广场是埃马努埃莱二世，意大利王国的第一位国王的名字命名。

威尼斯

- 圣马可广场 - 又称威尼斯中心广场，一直是威尼斯的政治、宗教和传统节日的公共活动中心。
- 叹息桥 - 位于意大利威尼斯圣马可广场附近，公爵府（总督府）侧面的一座巴洛克风格的石桥。此条叹息桥是密封式拱桥建筑，由内向外望只能通过桥上的小窗子。叹息桥的两端连接法院与监狱两处，死囚通过此桥之时，常是行刑前的一刻，因感叹即将结束的人生而得名；是威尼斯最著名的桥梁之一。
- 圣马可大教堂 - 矗立于威尼斯市中心的圣马可广场上。它曾是中世纪欧洲最大的教堂，是威尼斯建筑艺术的经典之作，它同时也是一座收藏丰富艺术品的宝库。
- 里阿尔托桥 - 是意大利威尼斯3座横跨大运河的桥梁之一，也是其中最古老的一座。里阿尔托桥属于文艺复兴风格，也被称为“白色巨象”，两旁则是市场及餐厅。

ROME

- **Roman Forum** - Is a rectangular forum (plaza) surrounded by the ruins of several important ancient government buildings at the center of the city of Rome.
- **Trevi Fountain** - Is a fountain in the Trevi district in Rome, Italy, designed by Italian architect Nicola Salvi and completed by Pietro Bracci. It is the largest Baroque fountain in the city and one of the most famous fountains in the world.
- **Colosseum** - Built of concrete and stone, it was the largest amphitheatre of the Roman Empire, and is considered one of the greatest works of Roman architecture and engineering. It is the largest amphitheatre in the world.

VATICAN CITY

- **St. Peter's Square** - Is a massive plaza located directly in front of St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican City, the papal enclave inside Rome, directly west of the neighbourhood or rione of Borgo.
- **St. Peter's Basilica** - Is a Late Renaissance church located within Vatican City. St. Peter's is the most renowned work of Renaissance architecture and remains one of the largest churches in the world.

FLORENCE

- **Piazzale Michelangelo** - Designed in 1869 by Florentine architect Giuseppe Poggi, Piazzale Michelangelo offers panoramic views of Florence and the Arno valley and is a popular spot with locals and tourists.
- **Ponte Vecchio** - Is a Medieval stone closed-spandrel segmental arch bridge over the Arno River, in Florence, Italy, noted for still having shops built along it, as was once common.
- **Giotto Bell Tower** - Is a free-standing campanile that is part of the complex of buildings that make up Florence Cathedral on the Piazza del Duomo in Florence, Italy.

PISA

- **Leaning Tower of Pisa** - Or simply the Tower of Pisa is the campanile, or freestanding bell tower, of the cathedral of the Italian city of Pisa, known worldwide for its unintended tilt to one side and is the third oldest structure in Pisa's Cathedral Square after the Cathedral and the Baptistery.

CINQUE TERRE

- **Cinque Terre** - which means Five Lands, comprise the five small coastal villages of Riomaggiore, Manarola, Corniglia, Vernazza and Monterosso located in the Italian region of Liguria. They are listed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.

Florentine Steak

- **Monterosso al Mare** - is a town and comune in the province of La Spezia, part of the region of Liguria. It is one of the five villages in Cinque Terre. The area is famous for its many lemon trees and It is also renowned for its white wines, grapes, and olives.
- **Vernazza** - is one of the 5 centuries-old villages that make up the Cinque Terre, on northwest Italy's rugged Ligurian coast. Colorful houses surround its small marina. The Santa Margherita di Antiochia Church has a bell tower topped by an elegant cupola. Clinging to the rocks, Doria Castle is a medieval defensive structure with a cylindrical tower.
- **Corniglia** - is a frazione of the comune of Vernazza in the province of La Spezia, Liguria, northern Italy. Corniglia is not directly adjacent to the sea. To reach Corniglia, it is necessary to climb the Lardarina leads to the village.
- **Manarola** - is a small town, a frazione of the comune of Riomaggiore, in the province of La Spezia, Liguria, northern Italy. It is the second-smallest of the famous Cinque Terre towns frequented by tourists. Most of the houses are bright and colourful. Manarola's primary industries have traditionally been fishing and wine-making. The Via dell'Amore ("Love's Trail") is a path connecting Riomaggiore to its frazione Manarola, also part of the Cinque Terre.
- **Riomaggiore** - is a village and comune in the province of La Spezia, situated in a small valley in the Liguria region of Italy. It is the first of the Cinque Terre one meets when travelling north from La Spezia.

MILAN

- **Sforza Castle** - It was built in the 15th century by Francesco Sforza, Duke of Milan, on the remains of a 14th-century fortification. Largely remade by Luca Beltrami in 1891–1905, it now houses several of the city's museums and art collections.
- **Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II** - Is one of the world's oldest shopping malls. Housed within a four-story double arcade in central Milan, the Galleria is named after Vittorio Emanuele II, the first king of the Kingdom of Italy.

VENICE

- **St Mark's Square** - Overlooks one of the most beautiful squares in the world, a real marble salon, the city center for centuries.
- **Bridge of Sigh** - Is a bridge located in Venice, northern Italy. The enclosed bridge is made of white limestone and has windows with stone bars. It passes over the Rio di Palazzo and connects the New Prison to the interrogation rooms in the Doge's Palace.
- **St Mark's Cathedral** - Is the cathedral church of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Venice. It is the most famous of the city's churches and one of the best known examples of Italo-Byzantine architecture.
- **Rialto Bridge** - Is one of the four bridges spanning the Grand Canal in Venice, Italy. It is the oldest bridge across the canal, and was the dividing line for the districts of San Marco and San Polo.
