圣彼得堡

- 涅瓦大街 涅瓦大街是圣彼得堡最热闹最繁华的街道。这里聚集了最大的书店、食品店、最大的百货商店和最昂贵的购物中心。而且还可以欣赏到各种教堂,名人故居以及历史遗迹。但因为这里的建筑物都有不能超过冬宫高度的限制,所以最终形成了今日高度整划,世界绝无仅有的美丽街道。
- **喀山大教堂** 位于圣彼得堡的涅瓦大街,是圣彼得堡最大的教堂,始建于 1801年,如今仍在使用。这座教堂是为了存放俄罗斯东正教圣物《喀山圣 母像》而建的。据说喀山圣母曾于俄法战争期间显灵。
- 彼得保罗要塞 是一座六面体的城堡,坐落在圣彼得堡市中心涅瓦河右岸,是圣彼得堡最古老的建筑。该城堡于1703年5月27日由彼得大帝在兔子岛上奠基,与圣彼得堡同龄。要塞最初的建设目的是为了防卫,后来改成了关押政治犯的监狱,随后又用来监控涅瓦河上往来的船只。要塞中有彼得保罗大教堂、钟楼、圣彼得门、彼得大帝的船屋、造币厂、兵工厂、克龙维尔克炮楼、十二月革命党人纪念碑等建筑物。彼得堡罗大教堂建原是木质,后来在原处改建为石砌大教堂,是一座早期俄罗斯巴洛克式大教堂。
- 彼得宫 俄罗斯夏宫又称彼得宫,是圣彼得堡的第一座王宫,是历代沙皇避暑行宫。坐落在芬兰湾南岸的森林中,它始建于1714年,分为上花园和下花园,大宫殿在上花园。这里的建筑豪华壮丽,被誉为"俄罗斯的凡尔赛宫"。大宫殿前是一个巨大的阶梯形瀑布群,称为大瀑布也就是著名的隆姆松喷泉。
- **艾尔米塔什博物馆** 冬宫音译为艾尔米塔什,是俄罗斯历代沙皇的宫殿。1764年由叶卡捷琳娜二世女皇创建,收藏着世界各地珍贵的艺术品、名画、历史文物共计270多万件。十月革命后辟为圣彼得堡国立艾尔米塔什博物馆的一部分,是世界四大博物馆之一,与巴黎的卢浮宫、伦敦的大英博物馆、纽约的大都会艺术博物馆齐名。现在的冬宫与小艾尔米塔什、旧艾尔米塔什、艾尔米塔什剧院、冬宫储备库、新艾尔米塔什形成了一个总面积达一百三十万平米的古建筑群,成为世界上最大最古老的博物馆之一。
- 尼古拉耶夫斯基宫 尼古拉宫并不是过去俄国沙皇的住所,当初士尼古拉一世为了他的子女所建的宫殿。后来成为他三儿子尼古拉耶维奇大公的宫殿。现在的尼古拉耶夫斯基宫不仅是圣彼得堡的豪华宫殿之一,你还可以观赏俄罗斯民俗舞蹈表演"感觉自己是俄罗斯人"。并安排于中场时间举办鸡尾酒会,享用伏特加酒及鱼子酱等点心。在悠扬的钢琴声中享用宫廷晚宴,尽情感受旧时王宫贵族的奢华气氛。
- **圣彼得堡涅瓦河游船** 乘坐游船,畅游圣彼得堡。欣赏水道纵横,桥梁 遍布的涅瓦河旖旎风光。

- 麻雀山 麻雀山位于莫斯科西南,是莫斯科的最高处,最高处海拔高度为220米,莫斯科河从山脚流过。得名于1451年以牧师 Vorobey(意为麻雀)命名的一个村庄。而在1924年至1991年期间,为了纪念列宁而一度更名为列宁山。在麻雀山山顶上有观景台,观景台正对莫斯科大学的正门,由此可俯瞰莫斯科河与莫斯科市区,美丽景色尽收眼底。到这里来的,除慕名而至的各国游客外,多是本地举行婚礼的新人及其亲友。
- **红场** 原名"托尔格",意为集市,1662年改为"红场",意为"美丽的广场"。红场位于市中心,是国家举行各种大型庆典及每年一度的阅兵式地点。见证了俄罗斯民族的历史与往昔的辉煌,是世界上著名的广场之一。
- 圣巴西尔大教堂 该教堂普遍称为"圣瓦西里教堂"。为俄罗斯东正教堂,被誉为俄罗斯最美丽的教堂。以九个形态和颜色各异的洋葱头教堂顶闻名于世,堪称克里姆林宫和红场一带的地标建筑。精美绝伦的建筑艺术在这里呈现得淋漓尽致,现在这里已经成为国家历史博物馆的一部分,内部有很多东欧民族16世纪前后的壁画值得鉴赏。
- **克里姆林宫** 克里姆林宫是位于俄罗斯首都莫斯科市中央行政区特维尔区的一个建筑群,同时是俄罗斯总统驻地。其南面俯瞰莫斯科河,东临圣巴西尔大教堂与红场,西接亚历山大花园与无名烈士墓。四周由宫墙围四座宫殿,四座大教堂,十九座塔楼而成,是俄罗斯克里姆林式建筑的代表之作。从远处遥望克里姆林宫,一座建筑高高地矗立在建筑群体中,有个高大建筑在教堂广场上的伊凡大帝钟楼,是古时的信号台和望台。左侧有重达40吨的炮王,右侧是着名的钟王。这两个庞然大物虽然从未使用过,但却显示出了俄罗斯工匠高超的铸造技术。

ST PETERSBURG

- The Nevsky Prospect today functions as the main thoroughfare in Saint Petersburg. The majority of the city's shopping and nightlife are located on or right off the Nevsky Prospekt.
- Kazan Cathedral also known as the Cathedral of Our Lady of Kazan, is a cathedral of the Russian Orthodox Church on the Nevsky Prospekt in Saint Petersburg. It is dedicated to Our Lady of Kazan, probably the most venerated icon in Russia. The construction was started in 1801 and continued for ten years while being supervised by Alexander Sergeyevich Stroganov.
- The Peter and Paul Fortress is the original citadel of St. Petersburg, Russia, founded by Peter the Great in 1703 and built to Domenico Trezzini's designs from 1706 to 1740.[1] In the early 1920s, it was still used as a prison and execution ground by the bolshevik government. Today it has been adapted as the central and most important part of the State Museum of Saint Petersburg History. The museum has gradually become virtually the sole owner of the fortress building, except the structure occupied by the Saint Petersburg Mint.
- The Peterhof Palace is a series of palaces and gardens located in Petergof, Saint Petersburg, Russia, laid out on the orders of Peter the Great. These palaces and gardens are sometimes referred as the "Russian Versailles". The Grand Palace at Peterhof was designed to be the centerpiece of Peter the Great's "Russian Versaille". Around 1720, the Tsar gave up on attempts to establish his court at Strelna, mainly because the boggy ground proved entirely unsuitable for the canals and fountains that he envisioned. Moving his attentions further west to Peterhof, the Tsar began to draw up his own plans for the grounds and palace.
- Hermitage Museum is a museum of art and culture in Saint Petersburg, Russia. One of the largest and oldest museums in the world, it was founded in 1764 by Catherine the Great and has been open to the public since 1852. Its collections, of which only a small part is on permanent display, comprise over three million items (the numismatic collection accounts for about one third of them) including the largest collection of paintings in the world.
- Nikolaevski Palace The palace of Grand Duke Nikolai
 Nikolaievich of Russia forms part of a sprawling complex incorporating a
 palatial church, a manege, and several outbuildings separated from
 Labour Square by a cast-iron fence.
- Saint Petersburg River Cruise (Russia) Embark on a river cruise to see the famed draw bridges from below, to feel the fresh air from the Gulf of Finland. Witness with a most dramatic and beautiful scenery: the lights of St. Petersburg at night which reveals the city's charm in full at dusk.

MOSCOW

- Sparrow Hills is the name of a location in the south-west of Moscow, positioned on the high right bank of the Moscow River and covered in forest. It is located opposite Luzhnikov, one of the seven hills of Moscow. The hills stretch from the mouth of the River Setuna to the Andreev Bridge (on the small ring of the Moscow railroad). In the north, they are bordered by the Neskuchny garden.
- Red Square is a city square (plaza) in Moscow, Russia. It separates the Kremlin, the former royal citadel and currently the official residence of the President of Russia, from a historic merchant quarter known as Kitai-gorod. Red Square is often considered the central square of Moscow since Moscow's major streets, which connect to Russia's major highways, originate from the square.
- St Basil's Cathedral commonly known as The Cathedral of Vasily the Blessed, is a church in Red Square in Moscow, Russia. The building now a museum, if officially known as the Cathedral of the intercession of the Most Holy Theotokos on the Moat or Pokrovsky Cathedral. It was built from 1556 61 on orders from Ivan the Terrible and commemorates the capture of Kazan and Astrakhan. A world famous landmark, it was the city's tallest building until the completion of the Ivan the Great Bell Tower in 1600.
- Kremlin The name Kremlin means "fortress inside a city". The Moscow Kremlin usually referred to as the Kremlin, is a fortified complex at the heart of Moscow, overlooking the Moskva River to the south, Saint Basil's Cathedral and Red Square to the east, and the Alexander Garden to the west. It is the best known of the kremlins (Russian citadels) and includes five palaces, four cathedrals, and the enclosing Kremlin Wall with Kremlin towers.
