(MOSCOW 莫斯科 - St Petersburg 圣彼得堡)

第一天 吉隆坡 + 莫斯科

[机上用餐/晚]

集合机场, 然后飞往莫斯科。晚餐后, 入住酒店并过夜。

- [**莫斯科地铁之旅**] 参观独特而美丽的地铁站。
- [阿尔巴特街]-俄罗斯首都现存最古老的街道之一。

第二天 莫斯科

[早/午/晚]

- [Sergiev Posad 修道院]-是最重要的俄罗斯修道院,是俄罗斯东正教的精神中心。
- [圣三一大教堂]-建于1423年的蹲坐式金圆顶三一大教堂是修道院的心脏,也是现存最古老的建筑。
- [马戏表演]-今晚,您将欣赏俄罗斯著名的马戏表演。

第三天 莫斯科

[早/午/晚]

- [红场]-欣赏著名的克里姆林宫,斯帕斯卡亚钟楼和圣巴西尔大教堂的彩色螺旋洋葱圆顶。
- [GUM 百货商店]-GUM 中超过 100 个世界著名品牌。
- 「**徒步旅行**]-喀山大教堂,国家历史博物馆,复活门和列宁陵墓的景色。
- [克里姆林宫] 一进入并参观3个大教堂。克里姆林宫被认为是俄罗斯权力和力量的象征。
- [博物馆] 参观历史最悠久,最负盛名的博物馆,该博物馆收藏着沙阜的手工艺品,俄罗斯和外国的珠宝及盔甲。

第四天 莫斯科 - 圣彼得堡

[早/午/晚]

- [DIY Matryoshka 娃娃] 体验和绘画自己的 Matryoshka 娃娃。
- [高速火车]-大约需要 4 个小时才能到达圣彼得堡。
- [彼得夏宮大皇宮]-参观建筑师的杰作和彼得大帝最喜欢的住所(包括喷泉公园的入口)。
- [凯瑟琳宫] 是宫殿与公园合奏的历史和组成中心。

第五天 圣彼得堡

[早/午/晚]

- [彼得保罗要塞] 参观俄罗斯圣彼得堡一座昔日的城堡。
- [圣以撒大教堂] 俄罗斯的大型俄罗斯东正教博物馆。
- [涅瓦大街]- 圣彼得堡的主要街道,在这种艺术和历史的大道上尽情购物。(如果时间允许)
- **[滴血救世主教堂]** 俄罗斯圣彼得堡的主要景点之一。(拍照留念)

第六天 圣彼得堡

[早/午/晚]

- [运河游船] 享受令人赞叹的运河巡游, 欣赏城市的美丽。
- [尼古拉耶夫斯基宫] 在尼古拉耶夫斯基宫欢送晚宴,并欣赏文化民俗表演。 (将提供伏特加酒和葡萄酒)。

第七天 圣彼得堡 > 吉隆坡

[早/午/晚]

- [冬宫博物馆与冬宫] 世界上第二大艺术博物馆, 当时凯瑟琳大帝女皇获得了令人印象深刻的绘画作品
- 晚餐后乘车送机场乘机返回温暖的家。

DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR – MOSCOW

[MOB/D]

- Gather at the airport and take flight to Moscow. After dinner, check in hotel and overnight.
- [Moscow Metro Tour] visit unique and beautiful metro stations.
- [Arbat Street] one of the oldest surviving streets of the Russian capital.

DAY 2 MOSCOW [B/L/D]

- [Sergiev Posad Monastery] is the most important Russian monastery and the spiritual centre of the Russian Orthodox Church.
- [St Trinity Cathedral] Built in 1423, the squat, gold-domed Trinity Cathedral is the heart of the monastery, as well as its oldest surviving building.
- [Circus Show] tonight, you will be entertained by the famous signature in Russia

DAY 3 MOSCOW [B/L/D]

- [Red Square] view the famous flanked by The Kremlin, Spasskaya Bell Tower and the brightly-coloured spiralling onion domes of St. Basil's Cathedral.
- [GUM Department Store] Over 100 of the world-famous brands in GUM.
- [Walking Tour] View of Kazan Cathedral, National Historical Museum, Resurrection Gate and Lenin's Mausoleum.
- [The Kremlin] enter and visit to the 3 Cathedrals. The Kremlin is perceived as a symbol of power and might of the Russian.
- [Armory Museum] Visit the oldest and most prestigious museum that boasts a staggering collection of Tsarist artefacts, Russian and foreign jewellery and armour.

DAY 4 MOSCOW – ST. PETERSBURG

[B/L/D]

- [DIY Matryoshka doll] experience and painting your own Matryoshka doll.
- [High Speed Train] About estimate 4 hours travel time to St Petersburg.
- [Grand Palace of Peterhof] visit a masterpiece of architects and the favourite residence of Peter the Great (include entrance to fountain park).
- [Catherine Palace] —is a historical and compositional center of the palace-and-park ensemble.

DAY 5 ST. PETERSBURG

[B/L/D]

- [Peter and Paul fortress] build by Peter the Great in the height of Northern War to protect the projected capital from possible Swedish attack.
- [St Isaac's Cathedral] a large Russian Orthodox museum in Russia.
- [Nevsky Prospect] St. Petersburg's main street, enjoy shopping on this avenue of art and history. (if time permit)
- [Church of Spilled Blood] one of the main sights of Saint Petersburg, Russia. (photo stop)

DAY 6 ST. PETERSBURG

[B/L/D]

- [Canal River Cruise] Enjoy the amazing canals cruise to see the beauty of the city.
- [Nikolaevsky Palace] Farewell dinner at the Nikolaevsky Palace and enjoy the Cultural Folklore Show. (Vodka and Wine will be served).

DAY 7 ST. PETERSBURG > KUALA LUMPUR

[B/L/D]

- [Hermitage Museum & Winter Palace] The second-largest art museum in the world, it was founded in 1764 when Empress Catherine the Great acquired an impressive collection of paintings
- After dinner and transfer to the Airport for your flight back to Kuala Lumpur.

DAY 8 ARRIVE KUALA LUMPUR

[MOB]
