## 香港

- 太平山-站在海拔373米的太平山顶上，您就像是乘坐飞机横越维多利亚港的上空，超过300万居民的香港市区一维港两岸的九龙半岛、香港岛北岸，将一一展现在您的眼前。就这样，一幢幢摩天大楼笔直的首立着，看似伸手可及。别忘了，香港是全球人口密度最高的城市之一。想象一下，当山下无数座大楼都同时亮起灯时，维港的海一面、维港的上空都被映照得发紫，那会是多么壮丽璀璨。
- 船游维多利亚港-爱维港的人，或许也会爱上天星小轮，因为乘小轮漫游维港，可以真正感受维港的美。美国的《国家地理旅游杂志》就曾将乘搭天星小轮游览维港，列为“人生50个必游项目”之一。自1888年起，天星小轮已开始接载香港市民穿梭维港，即使现在已有多条海底隧道及地铁贯通维港，每天仍有很多市民选择搭乘天星小轮。
- 大埔林村-早在700多年前的宋朝末年，就已经有乡人聚居。村里的许愿树和天后庙是本地人与游客祈福许愿的胜地，在农历新年时尤其热闹。
- 石板街-真实名称是砵典乍街 (Pottinger Street)，是香港政府在 1858 年以香港的第一任港督亨利砵典乍爵士 (Sir Henry Pottinger) 的名字命名。砵典乍就是鸦片战争时指挥英军攻占舟山和长江一带的统帅，也是签定《南京条约》的英方权威代表。
- 金紫荆广场 - “永远盛开的紫荆花”雕塑 - 矗立于香港会议展览中心新翼海旁的博览海滨花园内。
- 香港仔渔村 - 香港仔是香港岛南端的一个渔村，拥有浓厚的渔港特色，使它至今乃旧是受众多游客喜爱的旅游观光之地，来此一游的人们更看重的是香港仔渔村与港湾共生的诗画之境，闻名遐迩的珍宝海鲜舫也坐落于此。
- 女人街-位于旺角，是香港热门的露天集市，也是一众时装迷搜购时尚服饰的热点，外国游客必到的购物地点。

## 澳门

- 大三巴牌坊 - 为圣保禄教堂前壁遗址。该教堂建于1602年至1640年，原名为“天主之母”教堂，附属于其旁的圣保禄学院。两者均毁于1835年之大火，“三巴”是“圣保禄” (São Paulo) 之译音，前冠以“大”字，乃为区别另一座小三巴教堂。前壁遗址为23米宽，25.5米高，为巴洛克风格，以花岗岩建成，上下共分五层，上有内容丰富的石刻图案和青铜塑像。
- 威尼斯人度假酒店 - 是澳门的著名景点，它集酒店、会展、购物、体育、综艺及休闲设施于一体的综合性场所，是来澳门游客的必游之地。酒店以水都威尼斯为主题，内部布满威尼斯特色拱桥、小运河及石板路，充满意式浪漫狂放的异国风情。
- 永利皇宫缆车 - 观光缆车有如气派非凡的飞龙带您升上半空，尽情饱览表演胡的璀璨景点，然后再徐徐降落在花园之中，让你感受奢华的体验，热切期待永利皇宫中的每段精彩旅程。

## TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

### HONG KONG

- ◆ **Victoria Peak** - Standing on the top of the 373-meter-high Victoria Peak, you are flying across the Victoria Harbour. The city of Hong Kong with more than 3 million inhabitants - the Kowloon Peninsula on both sides of the Victoria Harbour, the north shore of Hong Kong Island will be one by one. Show it in front of your eyes. In this way, a skyscraper stands straight and seems to be within reach. Don't forget that Hong Kong is one of the most densely populated cities in the world. Imagine that when countless buildings at the foot of the mountain were lit at the same time, the sea bream of the Victoria Harbour and the sky above the Victoria Harbour were all purple, how magnificent it would be.
- ◆ **Victoria Harbour Night View Sightseeing** - Even locals can't get enough of Hong Kong's magnificent skyline at dusk. It looks incredibly serene as it's cast in hues of orange and pink, yet continues to bubble with action like recently popped champagne. This wonderful panorama is best experienced from the water on board a Hong Kong evening harbour cruise.
- ◆ **Tai Po Lam Tsuen Wishing Trees** - Was already a residential area 700 years ago during the Southern Song dynasty (1127-1279). Today, it still bustles with people and visitors thanks to its two 'wishing trees' and Tin Hau Temple. In the past, whenever there was a festival, villagers would throw joss paper into two trees and make wishes. They believed that the higher the branch the joss paper landed on, the more likely it was the wish would come true
- ◆ **Stone Street** - The real name is Pottinger Street, which was named after Hong Kong's first Hong Kong Governor Sir Henry Pottinger in 1858. The dynasty was the commander of the British army who captured the Zhoushan and the Yangtze River during the Opium War. It was also the British authority representative who signed the "Nanjing Treaty."
- ◆ **Golden Bauhinia Square** - located outside the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre on the Wan Chai waterfront marks the most significant occasion in Hong Kong's history.
- ◆ **Aberdeen Fishing Village** - Aberdeen, Hong Kong Island, the southern tip of a fishing village, has a strong fishing features, it has been used by many tourists is the favorite place for tourist to visit this one is that people pay more attention to the fishing village of Aberdeen Poetry and Harbour symbiosis of the environment, the world famous Jumbo Floating Restaurant is also located here.
- ◆ **Ladies' Market** - is a must visit destination for fashion lovers with an eye for bargain-priced clothing

### MACAO

- ◆ **Ruins of St. Paul's** - the ruins of the front wall of St. Paul's Church. The church was built between 1602 and 1640 and was originally called the "Mother of God" church, attached to St. Paul's College next to it. Both were destroyed by the fire of 1835. The "Sanba" is the transliteration of "São Paulo". The former title is "big", which is to distinguish another small tribal church. The front wall ruins are 23 meters wide and 25.5 meters high. They are baroque and built of granite. The upper and lower façades are divided into five layers with rich stone carvings and bronze statues.
- ◆ **Venetian Resort** - It is a famous attraction in Macau. It is a comprehensive place for hotels, exhibitions, shopping, sports, variety and leisure facilities. It is a must-see for Macao tourists. The hotel is themed around Venice, with Venetian arches, small canals and stone roads, full of Italian romantic wild exoticism.
- ◆ **Wynn Palace Cable Car** - The sightseeing cable car is like an extraordinary flying dragon. Take you to the air and enjoy the sights of Hu. Then you will land in the garden and let you experience the luxury experience. We look forward to every visit to the Wynn Palace. A wonderful journey.
