PHNOM PENH

- **Mekong River** - Explore Mekong River by boat, you can experience local people way of living.
- **Independence Monument** - This Monument was built in 1958, is designed to end French rule in Cambodia.
- **Norodom Sihanouk Statue** - A revered leader who guided the country to independence from France and through two wars before backing the genocidal Khmer Rouge regime in a bid to retain power.
- **Wat Phnom** - The only one hill in Phnom Penh, magnificent temple on the top of Wat Phnom, is the leisure place for local people.
- **Daun Penh Statue** - A statue of the legendary founder of the city of Phnom Penh.
- **Royal Palace** - It faces towards the East and is situated at the Western bank of the cross division of the Tonle Sap River and the Mekong River called Chaktomuk, surface magnificent.
- **Silver Pagoda** - Sits next to the Royal Palace, moniker 'Silver Pagoda' after the solid silver floor tiles that adorn the temple building.
- **Toul Sleng Museum** - Which is displays items of the inhuman acts of Pol Pot.
- **Chaktomuk River** - It was known as The 'Four Faces' - so called for its location at the four-branched confluence of the Mekong River.
- **Naga Resorts** - Which is the Cambodia biggest International Casino, itself also is five-star hotel.
- **Central Market** - The building has as its core a central dome, The Central Market is a bustling emporium of numerous stalls selling a wide variety of upmarket goods.

SIEM REAP

- **Wat Thmey (Killing Field)** - One of Siem Reap's modern temples. Serves as a memorial to the atrocities of the Cambodian civil war.
- **Angkor Night Market** - The Market harbors more than 100 shops and stalls offering souvenirs, handicrafts, clothes, books, DVDs, electronics, jewelry, art and there's even a travel agent, 3D movies...The shopping atmosphere is peaceful and relaxing.
- **Les Artisan D' Angkor** - Appreciation local art of handicraft, handicraft centre for your own shopping.
- **Seven Wonders of the World, Angkor Wat** - Is a symbol of Cambodia, visit to South Gate of Angkor Thom, Bayon, Baphoun, Phimeanakas, Ta Prohm Temple, Elephant Terrace, Terrace of the Leper King, Chao Say Devoda, Thommanon, Banteay Kdey, Srah Srong and the Grand Temple - Angkor Wat.
