PHNOM PENH

- **Royal Palace** - It faces towards the East and is situated at the Western bank of the cross division of the Tonle Sap River and the Mekong River called Chaktomuk, surface magnificent.
- **Silver Pagoda** - Sits next to the Royal Palace, moniker 'Silver Pagoda' after the solid silver floor tiles that adorn the temple building.
- **Independence Monument** - This Monument was built in 1958, is designed to end French rule in Cambodia.
- **Norodom Sihanouk Statue** - A revered leader who guided the country to independence from France and through two wars before backing the genocidal Khmer Rouge regime in a bid to retain power.
- **Naga Resorts** - Which is the Cambodia biggest International Casino, itself also is five-star hotel.
- **Toul Sleng museum** - Which is displays items of the inhuman acts of Pol Pot.

SIEM REAP

- **Angkor Panorama Museum** - Angkor Panorama Museum with site area of 6,115m2, located in Siem Reap, Cambodia, was inaugurated on 4th of December 2015. The painting fills the building's cylindrical central space with depictions of Cambodia's history: Jayavarman VII's bloody and ultimately victorious battle against invading Champa forces in the 12th century, his construction of the Bayon temple in the aftermath, and prosperous village life in his Angkor empire.
- **Wat Thmey (Killing Field)** - One of Siem Reap's modern temples. Serves as a memorial to the atrocities of the Cambodian civil war.
- **Cambodian Cultural Village** - Cambodian Cultural Village assembles all the miniatures of famous historical buildings and structures, local customs and practices of all races. There are 13 unique villages, which represent difference cultural heritages with 8 scenes of show performance. At each scene, the tourist will be able to enjoy with traditional dancing perform by our dancers that suitable to find out, the lifestyle landmark providing completed facilities and recreation services for both tourists and local community. Just a half day visit Cambodian Cultural Villages such as travel over Cambodia and getting to know about Cambodia, Cambodia Culture, Cambodia ethnic, Khmer Traditional, the significant people in Cambodia and more.
- **Angkor Night Market** - The Market harbors more than 100 shops and stalls offering souvenirs, handicrafts, clothes, books, DVDs, electronics, jewelry, art and there's even a travel agent, 3D movies...The shopping atmosphere is peaceful and relaxing.
- **Seven Wonders of the World, Angkor Wat** - Is a symbol of Cambodia, visit to South Gate of Angkor Thom, Bayon, Baphoun, Phimeanakas, Ta Prohm Temple, Elephant Terrace, Terrace of the Leper King, Chao Say Devoda, Thommanon, Banteay Kdey, Srah Srong and the Grand Temple - Angkor Wat.
- **Pre Rub Temple** - You can view the beautiful sunset and the view of Angkor Wat.
